WHW Year in Review

The mission of WHW is to provide comprehensive employment support services to empower disadvantaged men, women and teens to achieve economic self sufficiency through employment success. Since 1993, WHW has helped over 25,000 clients get and keep a job. Services provided include resume development and interviewing skills, educational workshops, computer classes, job placement services and interview appropriate professional apparel and image consulting. All of these services are provided *at no cost or obligation* to clients or our nonprofit partners. Over 80% of the clients we serve in our Job Development Program each year obtain employment and learn the skills they need to stay employed and provide for themselves and their families.

2010-2011 was an amazing year for WHW. During the course of the year, we provided our Employment Success Programs to over 3,000 men, women and teens. And after 13 years in Costa Mesa, WHW's Client Service Center moved to a spacious 8,200 square feet facility in Santa Ana. Our new Center is centrally located, close to public transportation and allows our staff and volunteers to provide all the personal service our clients need to be successful as a jobseeker.

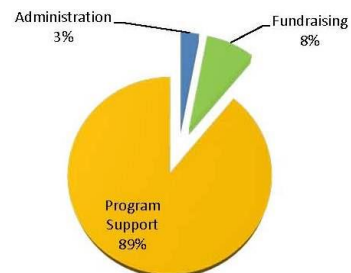
2010-2011 WHW Highlights
