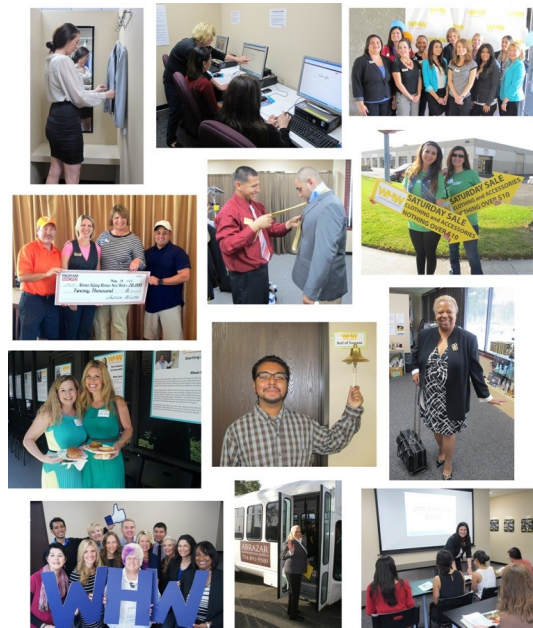




Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2012

WHW Year in Review

Since 1993, WHW (Women Helping Women/Men2Work) has helped over 40,000 clients get and keep a job. Services provided include employment readiness, resume development and interviewing skills, educational workshops, computer classes, interview appropriate professional apparel, image consulting and transportation services. **All of these services are provided at no cost or obligation to clients or our non-profit partners.**

2012-2013 was a very special year for WHW, as we celebrated **20 years of Empowering Employment Success!** With expanded services and record breaking support from our constituents, we continued our pattern of increasing the number of clients served every year.

2012-2013 WHW Highlights

- 4389 Employment Success Program Clients served
- 1071 Clients attended WHW Educational Workshops and Computer Training
- 403 Clients were served in the Employment Readiness Program
- 365 At Risk Teens served at Belle of the Ball
- Transportation Services provided 637 client trips, an increase of 88%!
- Almost 1000 Volunteers provided almost 17,000 hours of service
- 263 Nonprofit partners sent WHW their clients
- WHW received 2,097 in-kind donations to support our clients
