2016-2017 WHW Highlights

- **8,146 Job Seekers** participated in WHW's Employment Success Program
- **3,871 Job Seekers** attended WHW Employment Readiness Workshops
- **2,356 Job Seekers** participated in Computer Training Workshops
- **1,682 Job Seekers** received Professional Apparel and learned to put their best foot forward in their job search
- **83% of WHW Job Seekers** obtained employment within 3 months increasing their household income by over 300%
- **\$19.8 million** direct savings to local taxpayers in entitlement payments because WHW Job Seekers earned over \$80 million in wages
